

Regular Membership

Regular membership may be granted to Corvette owners, residing in Arizona, including spouse. The minimum age for regular membership shall be 21, excluding spouse. Regular membership may be granted to any individual provided he or she is residing in the same household as a regular member. Applications for membership shall be made in writing and submitted to the President. There shall be a mandatory probationary period before any prospective member shall be eligible for regular membership. During the probation period, the prospective member must attend a minimum of three (3) Club events, and meet all requirements specified on the application for membership. A prospective member shall pay non-member fees where applicable during the probation period. If all of the above requirements are satisfied, the Board of Directors shall vote on acceptance by a simple majority vote. If accepted, the prospective member becomes a regular member upon receipt of annual dues by the Treasurer. Regular membership entitles the member to all privileges and responsibilities of the Club. New members are highly encouraged to participate in Club activities and participate in the planning and running of activities.

No member of the Corvette Club of Arizona shall be allowed to hold membership in any other predominately Corvette marquee club located within 60 miles radius of the Corvette Club of Arizona's official meeting place. Exceptions shall be Corvette marquee organizations with local or regional chapters of nationwide membership. Examples include, but are not limited to WSCC, NCCC, NCRS, and NCOA.

Associate Membership

Associate membership shall be granted to those persons meeting the same admission requirements for regular members, with the exception of Corvette ownership, and are sponsored by a regular member. The minimum age for associate membership shall be 21. A regular member may sponsor only one associate member at any point in time. Club members who no longer own a Corvette shall be considered an associate member without sponsorship (1) at the end of the calendar year or (2) six months from the date of sale of their Corvette, whichever is longer. If dues become payable during the six-month period, the member pays the associate rate, but retains regular membership privileges until the end of said period. Upon purchase of a Corvette, the member pays the difference between the associate and the regular membership dues. Associate members may not vote or hold elected office.

Honorary Membership

Honorary membership shall be granted to those person deemed worthy by the Club criteria for consideration shall include: Contribution to the community; the propagation of the Corvette marquee; and persons who will add dignity and/or prestige to the Club. Any candidate for honorary membership must give his consent before being voted upon by the regular membership. Honorary members shall not vote, pay dues or hold elected office in the organization.

Annual Dues

2009 Dues are as follows:

\$60.00 - Associate Membership

\$75.00 - Single or Household Membership plus one NCCC membership

\$85.00 - Household Membership plus two NCCC memberships

Annual dues are payable October 1st, for the next calendar year and are delinquent as of November 1st. Regular household and associate membership dues shall be established in August of each year by the Board of Directors and approved by the regular membership.

Membership Lapse

Should membership lapse, there is a 30-day grace period without penalty, an additional 30 days with a \$5.00 late penalty, and after 60 days they must reapply for new membership with a \$5.00 penalty.

Calendar Year

The calendar year for the Corvette Club of Arizona shall run from January 1st through December 31st.

Resignation

Resignation of regular and associate members shall be governed by the rules covered in Article VI, Section 2, of the bylaws.
